XIIth Five Year plan proposed a comprehensive plan for State Higher Education System for ensuring the goals of Access, Equity and Excellence in Higher Education. The Finance Committee approved the proposal & on 3rd October 2013, RUSA got its identity as other Missions under Ministry of Human Resource Development . Govt. of Assam has constituted the Assam State Higher Education Council on 7th January 2014 , vide Executive order No: AHE 534/2013/13 dated 7th January 2014. This led to the formulation of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme, namely the Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA). Subsequently, the Assam State Higher Education Council Act 2017 has been enacted by the Govt. of Assam which came into force w.e.f 1st March 2018.

To attain higher levels of access, equity and excellence in the State higher education system with greater efficiency, transparency, accountability and responsiveness.


